

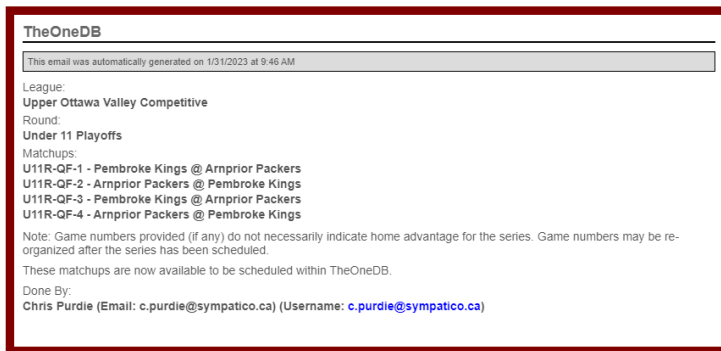
UPPER OTTAWA VALLEY MINOR HOCKEY LEAGUE

PLAYOFF MATCHUP SCHEDULING

Unlike the regular season, most playoff championship series games will not be scheduled by the league and the responsibility will be on the association ice allocators to determine the head-to-head series schedule.

MATCHUPS: HEAD-TO-HEAD SERIES

Once the round robin playoffs have been completed, the league scheduler will create matchups for the teams that will compete in a head-to-head series. Four matchups will be created however all four may not be needed for games since a team can advance with two wins.




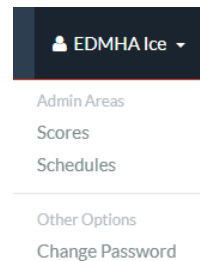
Once the matchups are created, Association Ice Allocators for the teams involved will receive an email notification. This is the indication that you should begin the scheduling process.

The highest placing team in the regular season standings will always have the first home game in all championship series, regardless of how they finished in the playoff standings.

SCHEDULING A MATCHUP

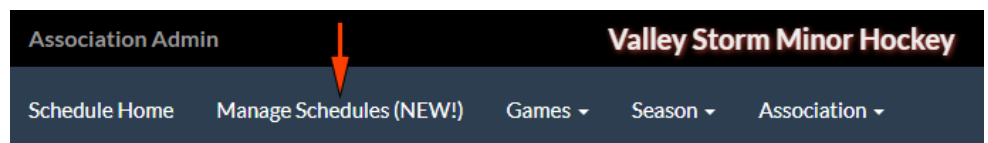
Scheduling a matchup is done within the OneDB and is basically the same process as rescheduling a game only the game will not already have a date assigned.

In the top right corner click the username drop down menu and select **Schedules**

In the Schedule Home page, from the menu bar at the top select **Manage Schedules**



On the next screen, the left side will list all the available teams by level. Any matchups that have been created but not yet scheduled will be highlighted in yellow. Ice allocators will only be able to schedule their home games. **Home games are in Red, away games are in Blue.**

Schedule Game

If a team has a practice scheduled (as shown in image to right, *5:00pm practice*), by selecting the radio button next to that practice will automatically overwrite the practice slot with the game. This is optional however in this situation if the button was not selected, both the game and practice would show in the schedule. The practice would simply need to be deleted from the association schedule separately in that case.

SCHEDULING GUIDELINES

Be sure to follow league scheduling guidelines that are found in the UOVMHL Constitution:

- Highest placing team in regular season standings has home ice for first and third games.
- Game 1 must be scheduled within the first four days of the playoff series date range.
- Game 3 is to be scheduled within the last four days of the date range, leaving at least the last day for contingency scheduling (ie fourth game, weather).
- The lower placed team is expected to schedule Game 2 between the dates provided by the higher placed team.

Ice allocators and managers should work together to generate a playoff schedule that will be mutually beneficial to both teams. While Game 3 is to be scheduled within those last four days, if Games 1 and 2 are scheduled early enough, Game 3 may be scheduled earlier as well which will leave more room for contingencies.
